



## **SPECIALIST SHORT COURSE FOR PRINT PROFESSIONALS**



### **INTRODUCTION**

For the first time ever, North India Printers' Association (NIPA), in collaboration with Glasgow Metropolitan College (GMC), Scotland UK has arranged an advance course for the professionals engaged in the Newspaper, Printing and Packaging industry to top-up their knowledge.

This 8 week course has specially been designed for the people in print in India. The training is to be provided at GMC, Glasgow Scotland (UK) under the supervision of qualified faculty.

The course studies will include lectures, demonstrations and practical workshops on advance printing press management procedures, costing & estimating and quality management etc. Visits to a range

of printing companies using state of art production equipment will be included within the course curriculum.

### **NUMBER OF STUDENTS**

The training will be provided in batches of minimum 16 and max. 18 students strictly of first come first served basis. A batch can be dropped in case sufficient students are not available and such students can be adjusted in next batch.

### **PROPOSED DATES**

(NIPA 3a) : October - December

(NIPA 3b) : January - February

(NIPA 3c) : March - April

(NIPA 3d) : May - June

\* The dates are subject to modification taking in view weather conditions and other technicalities

## QUALIFICATIONS

No formal qualification is essential, however, experience at supervisory or management level in a Newspaper, Printing or Packaging industry is essential. The course will be delivered in English and so an ability to communicate in English is required.

## ADMISSION

The admission is limited only for the persons sponsored by a Newspaper, Printing or Packaging unit. Teachers engaged in printing education can also apply for this course. The admission is strictly on first come first served basis. Training will be provided in batches of minimum 16 and max. 18 students.

## TUITION FEE

£ 1000 per person. Student shall meet their own accommodation, food and travel. However, Trust/GMC will provide information on best value accommodation available.

## SCHOLARSHIP

NIPA Educational Trust decided to offer up to two scholarships in every batch going for the 'Specialist Short Course for Print Professionals' at Glasgow. No tuition fee will be charged from up to two deserving students selected by the impartial panel of five eminent persons. ## REGISTRATION

Rs. 4500/- (non refundable)

Apply on the prescribed application form at least 2 months before the scheduled date of the group with registration fee of Rs. 4500/- (non refundable) in the name of NIPA Educational Trust, payable at Ludhiana, along with following documents:

- i) Photo copy of first 4 and last 4 pages of the passport.
- ii) Copy of last 3 years I/t return with PAN number
- iii) Letter of sponsorship from the printing, newspaper or packaging unit sponsoring your candidature.

iv) Complete details of the unit you are working

v) Latest I/t return with PAN number of the sponsor

Registration does not mean that the candidate is eligible for the admission. An independent board will select the candidates to be enrolled as students for this course. Right of admission is reserved the Trust can select/reject a candidate without assigning any reason and no correspondence will be entertained on the subject.

Every successful candidate will be issued a conditional letter by the GMC to deposit the tuition fee £1000 in advance with the GMC, Scotland UK. Once admitted the student will be issued definite

(unconditional) offer by GMC to apply for '*student visit*' visa. NIPA Educational Trust or GMC will not take any guarantee for the visa, however, visa advice and application support shall be provided to the candidates, free of cost, by the Sakun Educational Consultants Pvt. The college shall not refund tuition fees and the charges unless it determines at its sole discretion to do so. No refund shall be made for casual or any other type of absence from the course, however, tuition fee refund can be considered on production of visa rejected passport.
